

These students wanted to use their collective strength to promote academic excellence and to provide assistance to those in need. In March of 1913, the Founders of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. performed their first public act. They participated in the Women's Suffrage March in Washington, D.C. Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. was incorporated in 1930.



Keynote Speaker



Bishop Vashti Murphy McKenzie is the 117th elected and consecrated bishop of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. She is the first woman elected to episcopal office in more than two centuries of the denomination. She is the first woman to serve as President of the Council of Bishops, President of the General Board, Chair, the General Conference commission and host Bishop to the 2016 General Conference with more than 30,000 global attendees.

Currently, she serves as the presiding bishop of the 10th Episcopal District (Texas) and Chair of the Publications Commission, which is overseeing the construction of the new three-story AME Church Publishing House in Nashville, Tennessee. It is the first new denominational construction since the late 1970's.

Bishop McKenzie was appointed to serve by former President Barack Obama on the Advisory Council of the White House Faith-Based and Neighborhood Partnerships. She is the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Paul Quinn College, Dallas, Texas. Under her leadership, the 10th Episcopal District is doing a million-dollar renovation of the Richard Allen Chapel on the campus.

Bishop McKenzie is honored to serve as the National Chaplain of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

She is a graduate of the University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland, earned a Master of Divinity from Howard University, School of Divinity and earned a Doctor of Ministry from United Theological Seminary. She has several honorary doctoral degrees from prestigious universities and colleges.

Bishop McKenzie is the author of six books. The first two books, Not Without a Struggle and Strength in the Struggle concern leadership and professional growth for women. She revised Not Without A Struggle in 2012, as it remains a staple at seminaries and schools of religion. Her book Journey to the Well helps women seek new directions for personal growth and transformation following the footsteps of the Biblical Samaritan woman. Swapping Housewives tells the stories of Rachel, Jacob, and Leah an shares thee 21st-centruy implications for married and unmarried love. She edited an anthology of sermons from twenty-two preachers entitled, Those Sisters Can Preach. Her newest book is The Big Deal of Taking Small Steps to Move Closer to God. The Book Club Guide is available at www.vashtimckenzie.com or from her App Praycation.

She is the founder of the Selah, The Leadership Encounter for Women which creates a trusting environment allowing women leaders to focus on developing strategic networks with those in diverse industries to facilitate continued learning and support in their professional and personal growth. It is a holistic approach involving the heart, mind and soul sponsored by The Vashti Murphy McKenzie Foundation.

Bishop McKenzie is also the founder of Kerygma LLC, a media content provider. In the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina, she produced Survivor Stories which was broadcast on TV One and PBS Stations.

Bishop McKenzie, described as an "electrifying preacher", is a much sought after workshop and seminar presenter on leadership, transformation and women. She has a global preaching and teaching ministry that has taken her to Africa, Europe, the Holy Land, Canada and across the United States.

She is the wife of Dr. Stan McKenzie, former NBA player, who is the Supervisor of Missions, 10th Episcopal District AME Church. They are the parents of three adult children and one delightful grandchild.







Promise House embraces abused, neglected and homeless youth, giving them the support they need to live a better life. Since 1984, our lifesaving programs have empowered more than 75,000 youth and families to overcome trauma and crisis. Promise House is dedicated to providing the strength and stability that youth need today to build a brighter, more promising tomorrow.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Emergency Shelter

Promise House provides immediate shelter services to youth ages 0-21. The program incorporates therapeutic, educational and empowering services in a highly structured environment that stabilizes crisis situations, promotes family reunification and builds lifelong strenaths.

Long-Term Housing

Promise House offers long-term housing for older youth, including pregnant and parenting teens and their children. Youth live in group homes or individual apartments for up to two years and develop critical life skills, personal responsibility and financial independence while accessing a broad continuum of health, education and counseling services.

The Transitional Living Program houses young adults ages 16-24.

The Wesley Inn Program houses mothers ages 14-20 and babies ages 0-5.

COMMUNITY AND OUTREACH

Promise House helps struggling youth and their families develop self-sufficiency and extends critical resources to at-risk members of our community. We partner with physical and mental health care providers, county and state agencies, and schools to implement a comprehensive strategy for our non-residential clients' lifelong success.

The Street Outreach Program team scours Dallas streets to find homeless youth and provide them with lifesaving kits filled with hygiene products, non-perishable food and referral information.

The Community Counseling Program provides free case management services, parent education classes and individual, group and family counseling to the community at large.

Dallas Independent School District Drop-in Centers provide food, case management services and referrals to homeless students. Promise House partners with DISD to operate drop-in centers in district high schools.
